Ask Father Peter

Question: When do we bow and when do we genuflect?

Answer: We genuflect when entering and exiting the holy ground where the Lord is present. We genuflect towards the tabernacle, when it is filled with the Blessed Sacrament as a sign of adoration of the real presence of the Lord. How to genuflect: Take a step forward with the left foot and lower one's right knee to the ground. Bowing communicates respect, reverence and gratitude. We bow our heads at the very mention of the name "JESUS". We bow because we are grateful to be in this place, in this moment of prayer. We bow to the altar, to the cross, to any symbol that calls to mind what He's done for me. So we bow as a sign of respect when we recognize the symbols of the Lord. We genuflect when we recognize the Lord.


