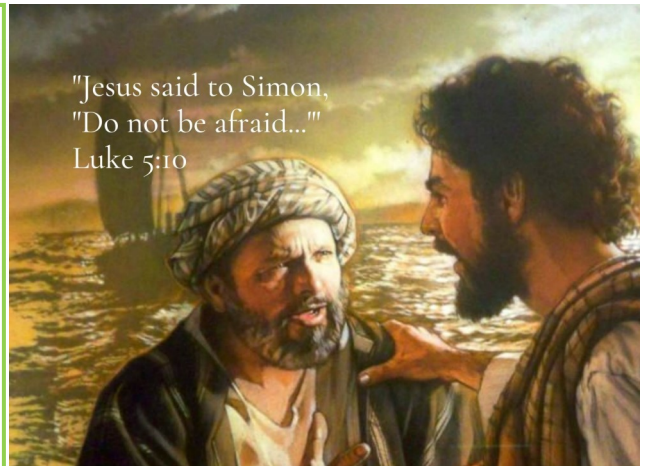

Reflect.
 Excerpts from Pope Francis' 'Homily - Opening of the Synodal Path (October 10th 2021)'.
 "...as we begin this synodal process, let us begin by asking ourselves - all of us - Pope, bishops, priests, religious and laity - are we prepared for the adventure of this journey?"
 Pope Francis invites us to reflect on these three verbs that characterize the Synod:

- ENCOUNTER**
 "Not so much by organizing events or theorizing about problems, as in taking time to encounter the Lord and one another."
- LISTEN**
 "True encounter arises only from listening. Whenever we listen with the heart (not just with ears), people feel that they are being heard, not judged. Are we good at listening? How good is the 'hearing' of our heart?"
- DISCERN**
 "We are invited 'to free ourselves from all that is worldly, including our inward-looking and outward pastoral models and to ask ourselves what it is that God wants to say to us in this time. And the direction in which he wants to lead us.'"

Every **3 minutes** another Canadian is diagnosed with diabetes.

29% of Canadians are currently living with diabetes or prediabetes.
 This will rise to **33%** by 2025 if current trends continue.

TODAY 3.4 million Canadians are estimated to be living with diabetes.

Diabetes is costing the country **\$14 billion** per year.

At least **1 in 10** deaths in Canadian adults was attributable to diabetes in 2008/09.

2025 That number is expected to reach more than **5 million** people in the next 10 years.
 In 10 years it will cost approximately **\$17.5 billion** per year.
