

### Ask Father Peter

**Question:** My friend has a daughter who is into reiki, crystals, "the Universe", and talks about grounding and Mother Earth. Is this contrary to Catholic belief?



**Answer:** Yes. Catholics should avoid New Age ideas and practices. These things are a direct violation of true Christian beliefs as this is entering the realm of superstition. The Bible warns against working with anything related to other gods (Buddha, Greek gods, etc.) superstition and the occult.

When believing that an item holds power, it takes away from believing in God's power. As well, when using items for protection or healing this is idolatry because it depends on spiritual forces other than God for healing and protection. Note that idolatry is forbidden in the Bible: (Deuteronomy 4:15–20; Jeremiah 44:1–4; 1 Corinthians 10:14–20; 2 Corinthians 6:16–17).

It is recommended that Christians avoid New Age ideologies. This includes things such as: horoscopes, rabbits feet, dream catchers, chakras, yoga, Ouija boards, and even having any books or videos in your home that specifically explain how to use these items.


