Ask Father Peter

Question: What do I do with blessed/religious articles (rosaries, crosses/crucifixes, etc.) that are broken, unusable or no longer wanted?

Answer: If the item has been blessed by a priest, it should be disposed of properly. If unsure, then treat the item as though it is blessed. There are a few things you can do with religious items:

- 1) If usable, give them away as gifts or donate them to a prison ministry or Catholic mission.
- 2) If broken or no longer usable, respectfully dispose of the item by burning or burying it.

However, if the item is NOT blessed, you can do any of the above or it can be thrown away.
