Ask Father Peter

Question: How come Easter isn't on the same date every year? How is Easter determined?



Answer: Jesus rose from the dead on the first Sunday following the feast of Passover. Early Christians didn't like being dependent on the pronouncements of rabbis for how to celebrate Christian feasts, so they came up with another way of determining the date. They decided that Easter would be celebrated on the first Sunday *after* (never *on*) the Paschal full moon. The Paschal full moon is the first full moon occurring on, or after, the spring equinox (March 21st). If the Full Moon is on a Sunday, Easter is celebrated on the following Sunday. As a result, Easter will always fall between March 22 & April 25.
