

Canada Needs Our Lady - Public Rosary Rally

Canada Needs Our Lady is an organization that started in Quebec and has been spreading across Canada. Each fall they organize rallies across the country to publicly pray Our Lady's favourite prayer - The Rosary. They started in 2014 with 39 public rosary sites and hope to hit 800 sites this year, with Martensville being one of those sites.

The Rosary Rally will take place <u>October 15th, 2022</u>, at <u>12:00 noon</u> at the corner of **4th** St. S & 8th Ave S (IHMP parking lot).

This year is the 105th anniversary of Our Lady's apparitions in Fatima. It was October 13th, 1917, when the miracle of the sun occurred in Fatima during Mary's apparition. Our Lady continually asked all of the world to pray the rosary during these apparitions.

There has likely never been a time in history and particularly in our beautiful country of Canada, when we have needed Our Lady more. When we pray the rosary in our home, Mary is so happy.
