

Mail-In Ballots for Catholic School Board Trustees - Civic elections are **Nov. 9**. Eligible voters for Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools (GSCS) Board of Education may apply for a mail-in ballot. When an application is approved, a ballot will be mailed to the voter. The application to vote by mail-in ballot must be received by the Returning Officer no later than **4 p.m. on Monday Oct. 26**. The ballot the voter receives from the Returning Officer must be received back no later than 8 p.m. on municipal election day – Monday Nov. 9, 2020. Any ballots received by the Returning Office after this deadline are deemed to be spoiled ballots. Forms and details can be found at www.gscs.ca/elections
